O R D E R

In today's hearing of the case, this Board has decided to grant the provisional reduction of fare for PUJ jitney service in Metro Manila only. In so far as the other regions are concerned, the Board is directing the Regional Directors to conduct proceedings for a roll back of fares, because the oil prices as reported by the regions as well as the fares are based on the prevailing prices in their respective regions. This provisional reduction of fare will take effect only in Metro Manila.

In the meantime, the Board will conduct further hearings, and will request a Comment/Recommendation on the prevailing prices of petroleum products in Metro Manila from the Department of Energy (DOE) as well as the Economic Impact Analysis from the National Economic Development Authority (NEDA) before the Board could finally decide on what would be the total decrease of fare.

The Board is now announcing the decrease of the minimum fare in METRO MANILA for the 1st 4 Km., from PhP8.50 to PhP7.50, there will be no change in the succeeding kilometer, it will remain PhP1.50 as stated in the Order on fare rates previously issued by the Board.

For the guidance of the PUJ Operators, Drivers and the riding public, this provisional decrease of fare is effective immediately today, and a revised fare matrix will be issued also today as a guide. The fare in Metro Manila has a PhP1.00 reduction from the original fare and this provisional fare remains until and after the Board shall have issued a final decision on the said Petition for fare roll back.
