



BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 02 Series of 2016

WHEREAS, the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) was created by Executive Order No. 202 on June 19, 1987, as administrative agency with quasi-judicial powers, and is the franchising and regulatory body for land transportation today;

WHEREAS, Baguio City will be celebrating its 21st Panagbenga Festival where an estimated 1.5 million tourists are expected to participate in its celebration;

WHEREAS, as per the letter of the officers of the Baguio Flower Festival Foundation Inc., there is a clamor for the granting of permits to public utility buses to schedule special trips to Baguio particularly during the staging of the Grand Street Dance Parade and Grand Float Parade slated on February 27 and February 28, 2016 respectively;

WHEREAS in view of the need to promote safety and convenience to commuters attending the Panagbenga Festival, the Board has decided to allow the acceptance and granting of special permits subject to the following conditions:

1. This shall only cover Public Utility Bus Service with valid and effective Passenger Accident Insurance Coverage.
2. The Application must be filed at least seven (7) days prior to the start of the duration of the Special Permit.
3. If the proposed route will originate or enter Metro Manila, the Application shall be filed at the Central Office and decided by the Board.
4. The CPC of the unit/s intended to be used must be valid during the period covering the Special Permit or that an Extension of Validity has been duly filed.
5. The CPC of the units/s intended to be used must not be suspended at the time of the filing and during the period covered by the Special Permit.
6. The proposed unit/s should not be more than ten (10) years old.
7. The fare should be the authorized fare on the applied route.
8. The Application should indicate the specific address of the terminals at both ends of the applied route.
9. The duration of the Special Permit shall be from February 26 to February 29, 2016 only.
10. The Board may deny the Application if the approval thereof would result in the abandonment of route, or the insufficiency of PUVs in the authorized route of the applicant.
11. The original copies of the Special Permit and the receipt of payment must always be carried by the driver during the trip.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board resolves to allow the acceptance of Applications for the Issuance of Special Permits to public utility buses going to Baguio City for the periods starting February 26, 2016 to February 29, 2016.
