BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 05, Series of 2015

WHEREAS, the Board issued Memorandum Circular (MC) No. 2004-016 (Re: Application for Issuance of Certificate of Public Convenience [CPC] to Operate Shuttle Service) excluding sedans, pick-ups, Asian utility vehicles, station wagons, and vans to be used as Shuttle Service;

WHEREAS, the Board issued MC No. 2006-014 (Re: Amnesty Program for Shuttle Service Providers for Workers within Clark Special Economic Zone) allowing any vehicle with a seating capacity of at least twenty-four (24) passengers or above to be used as Shuttle Service for workers employed by locators based at Clark Special Economic Zone;

WHEREAS, the Board issued MC No. 2008-010 (Re: Amendment to MC No. 2004-016) allowing vans and jeeps to be used as Shuttle Service for workers based at Special Economic Zones in Southern Luzon;

WHEREAS, our Regional Office – Cordillera Administrative Region favorably indorsed the Letter-Request of St. Louis University (SLU), Baguio City asking for exemption from the coverage of MC No. 2004-016 due to the following factors:

1. Buses, mini-buses, or coasters take a longer time to be filled up considering the seating capacity of such types of vehicles, which would not effectively cater to the almost hourly transport need of its faculty members, students and employees;
2. Such types of vehicles are also too large for the large curves and narrow arteries which could be with steep down-grade or up-grade roads that are ubiquitous in Baguio City;

WHEREAS, after review of our existing issuances, the Board deems it necessary to allow the use of vans or other utility types of vehicles as Shuttle Service for the use of St. Louis University, Baguio City;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board resolves as it is hereby resolved that:

1. The use of vans or other utility types of vehicles as Shuttle Service shall only be allowed from SLU Main Campus to other SLU campuses and SLU housing projects for the exclusive use of students, employees, faculty members and officials;
2. The Contract of Shuttle Service between SLU and Applicant must be submitted at the filing of the Application for the Issuance of CPC;
3. The conditions set forth in MC No. 2004-016 should be complied with at the filing of the Application;

4. "SHUTTLE SERVICE" should be painted in bold letters (8 inches by 2 inches) at both sides of the proposed unit;
5. The units proposed to be applied should at least be three (3) years old from the date of manufacture;
6. Maximum age limit for Shuttle Service units shall be fifteen (15) years pursuant to the policy of the Department;
7. This Resolution shall solely be applicable to Shuttle Service for the exclusive use of students, faculty members and officials of SLU, Baguio City.
8. This Resolution shall only be valid for six (6) months from issuance hereof, subject to renewal and recommendation of the CAR-Regional Office.
