DEPARTMENT ORDER NO. 2009-36

Subject

ESTABLISHMENT OF INTERMODAL STATIONS /

TERMINALS

Pursuant to the Department's mandate as the primary policy, planning, programming, coordinating, implementing, regulating and administrative agency of the Government in the promotion, development and regulation of dependable and coordinated networks of transportation and communications systems as well as in the fast, safe, efficient and reliable postal, transportation and communications services, and in order to provide the public easy and convenient access to all modes of transportation services, all civil aviation, maritime, rail and road transport offices and agencies of the government are hereby directed to inter-connect their transportation systems via the establishment of common intermodal stations and terminals.

Specifically, all agencies/entities of the government engaged in the operation of public railway transportation services, including the Philippine National Railways (PNR), the Light Rail Transit Authority (LRTA), the Metro Manila Transit Corporation (MRTC), the North Luzon Railway Corporation (NORTHRAIL), the Panay Railways, Inc. (PRI), the Cebu Railway Project Office (CRPO) and the Mindanao Railway Project Office (MRPO) are hereby directed to connect, where technically and financially viable, their railway systems to airports, bus terminals and seaports.

In Metropolitan Manila area, all offices and entities of the government engaged in the operation of public railway transportation services which includes the LRT Line 1, LRT Line 2, MRT 3 and MRT 7 are further directed to establish common stations/terminals in cases where their railway systems converge in one area.

All other issuances and directives inconsistent herewith are hereby revoked and/or modified accordingly.

This order shall take effect immediately.
