DEPARTMENT ORDER 2010-34

SUBJECT : GUIDELINES FOR APPROVAL OF SALE AND TRANSFER OF CERTIFICATES OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE (CPCs)

Under the Public Service Act, the alienation, sale, mortgage or lease of Certificates of Public Convenience (CPCs) and properties of public utility operators is allowed after notice to the public and hearing of the parties to the transaction at a public hearing upon demonstration of just and reasonable grounds for the alienation, sale or encumbrance of the CPCs or properties subject of the transaction.

This authority under the Public Service Act is premised on the current validity and existence of the CPCs conveyed; the financial and technical qualifications of the transferees of the CPCs conveyed; and the payment of all fees/dues to the government, including taxes.


To eliminate the sale and transfer of expired and/or dead CPCs which has become prevalent, the following guidelines are issued:

- 1) No application for the approval of sale and transfer of a CPC shall be accepted where the validity of the CPC being conveyed is less than six (6) months on the date of its filing with the LTFRB;
- 2) No application for the approval of sale and transfer of a CPC shall be accepted unless the units authorized therein are registered with the LTO for the current year;
- 3) Where the authorized units under the CPC conveyed have not all been registered with the LTO for the current year, the application for the approval of sale and transfer will be accepted and processed only for the actual number of registered units corresponding to the CPC conveyed, and;
- 4) No application for the approval of sale and transfer of a CPC shall be accepted unless all fees/dues have been fully paid to the LTO and LTFRB and taxes, to the BIR.

All other issuances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby modified, amended or superseded accordingly.

This Department Order takes effect immediately.
