BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 011
SERIES OF 2018

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation (DOTr) issued Department Order No. 011, Series of 2017, otherwise known as the Omnibus Guidelines on the Planning and Identification of Public Road Transportation Services and Franchise Issuance or the Omnibus Franchising Guidelines (OFG), which aims to provide a reliable, safe, adequate, accessible, environment-friendly, dependable, efficient, and comfortable public road transportation throughout the country;

WHEREAS, the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB), a sectoral agency of the DOTr, is tasked to implement the OFG;

WHEREAS, the DOTr has likewise tasked LTFRB to determine appropriate routes for the PUV Modernization Program (PUVMP) for its initial implementation;

WHEREAS, the LTFRB is empowered, under Section 5 of Executive Order No. 202, to, among others, prescribe and regulate routes of service, and zones or areas of operation of public land transportation services provided by motorized vehicles in accordance with the public land transportation development plans and programs of the DOTr;

WHEREAS, the LTFRB has identified the **PM Jeepney Drivers and Operators Services, Inc.**, as one of the groups for the initial implementation in Metro Manila of the PUV Modernization Program as embodied in the OFG;

WHEREAS, after consultation and survey, the LTFRB has identified appropriate route for **PM Jeepney Drivers and Operators Services, Inc.** in line with the implementation of the OFG;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Board hereby **RESOLVES** as it is **RESOLVED** to

1. **GRANT** the route **SM MASINAG (Antipolo) to SM FAIRVIEW (Quezon City)** to **PM Jeepney Drivers and Operators Services, Inc.**, with the following route description:

From SM Masinag (Antipolo) to Marcos Highway, right turn to Gil Fernando Street, left to Aquillina Street, right to E. Santos Street, A. De Guzman Street, left to Paraluman Street, Sampaguita Street, Dahlia Street, right to J.P. Rizal Street, left to Batasan-San Mateo Road, right to Batasan Road up to Litex Market, right to Commonwealth Avenue, right to Regalado Avenue up to SM Fairview and back via Regalado Avenue, left to Commonwealth Avenue, left to Batasan-San Mateo Road, right to J.P. Rizal Avenue, to Bayan-Bayanan Avenue, to E. Rodriguez Avenue, left to Aquilina Street, right to Gil Fernando up to Marcos Highway and back to SM Masinag (Antipolo)

2. **AUTHORIZE PM Jeepney Drivers and Operators Services, Inc.** with **fifteen (15) units** for the initial implementation subject to subsequent review as may be necessary.

3. **DIRECT PM Jeepney Drivers and Operators Services, Inc.** to file the necessary application for New Certificate of Public Convenience to operate PUJ Service in accordance with the requirements of the OFG. Upon granting of the CPC, all units previously granted to **PM Jeepney Drivers and Operators Services, Inc.** and to its individual members (if any) shall be cancelled and the units therein be dropped as public utility.
4. **DIRECT PM Jeepney Drivers and Operators Services, Inc. to strictly comply with the requirements of the OFG** including vehicle specifications, fleet management, provision for off-street terminal and garage for units, availability of transport safety officers, automated payment, closed-circuit television (CCTV), global navigation satellite system (GNSS), as well as applicable Circulars issued by the LTFRB.
