BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 035
SERIES OF 2018

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation (DOTr) issued Department Order No. 011, Series of 2017, otherwise known as the Omnibus Guidelines on the Planning and Identification of Public Road Transportation Services and Franchise Issuance or the Omnibus Franchising Guidelines (OFG), which aims to provide a reliable, safe, adequate, accessible, environment-friendly, dependable, efficient, and comfortable public road transportation throughout the country;

WHEREAS, the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB), a sectoral agency of the DOTr, is tasked to implement the OFG;

WHEREAS, the DOTr has likewise tasked LTFRB to determine appropriate routes for the PUV Modernization Program (PUVMP) for its initial implementation;

WHEREAS, the LTFRB is empowered, under Section 5 of Executive Order No. 202, to, among others, prescribe and regulate routes of service, and zones or areas of operation of public land transportation services provided by motorized vehicles in accordance with the public land transportation development plans and programs of the DOTr;

WHEREAS, the LTFRB has identified the **Pateros Fort Bonifacio Transport Service and Multi-Purpose Cooperative**, as one of the groups for the initial implementation in Metro Manila of the PUV Modernization Program as embodied in the OFG;

WHEREAS, after consultation and survey, the LTFRB has identified appropriate route for **Pateros Fort Bonifacio Transport Service and Multi-Purpose Cooperative** in line with the implementation of the OFG;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Board hereby **RESOLVES** as it is **RESOLVED** to

1. **GRANT** the route **Guadalupe – Fort Bonifacio Gate 3** to **Pateros Fort Bonifacio Transport Service and Multi-Purpose Cooperative**, with the following route description:

FORT BONIFACIO (GATE 3) – GUADALUPE MARKET (ABC)

Start Gate 3 terminal, inside Fort Bonifacio, Lawton Ave., Bayani Rd., Lt. Gen. Alfonso Arellano, U-turn back to Bayani Rd., Lawton Ave., Market Market, Gate 1, Kalayaan Ave., P. Yabut St., Manggahan St., right to Magsaysay, MCDA terminal and back to J.P. Rizal Ext., Lawton Ave. Up to Gate 3 terminal.

2. **AUTHORIZE** **Pateros Fort Bonifacio Transport Service and Multi-Purpose Cooperative** with **one hundred thirty seven (137) units with seating capacity of twenty two (22) passengers per unit** for the initial implementation subject to subsequent review as may be necessary.

3. **DIRECT Pateros Fort Bonifacio Transport Service and Multi-Purpose Cooperative** to file the necessary application for New Certificate of Public Convenience to operate PUJ Service in accordance with the requirements of the OFG. Upon granting of the CPC, all units previously granted to **Pateros Fort Bonifacio Transport Service and Multi-Purpose Cooperative** and to its individual member (if any) shall be cancelled and the units therein be dropped as public utility.
4. **DIRECT Pateros Fort Bonifacio Transport Service and Multi-Purpose Cooperative** to strictly comply with the requirements of the OFG including vehicle specifications, fleet management, provision for off-street terminal and garage for units, availability of transport safety officers, automated payment, closed-circuit television (CCTV), global navigation satellite system (GNSS), as well as applicable Circulars issued by the LTFRB.
