**DATE** : August 8, 2018

**SUBJECT** : **Amendment to Memorandum Circular No. 2015-017** (Prescribing New Period of Validity of Provisional Authority for TNVS)

**WHEREAS**, one of the powers and functions of Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board under Executive Order No. 202 is to formulate, promulgate, administer, implement, and enforce rules and regulations on land transportation public utilities ..x x x ..;

**WHEREAS**, on 28 May 2015, the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board issued **Memorandum Circular No. 2015-017** (Implementing Guidelines on the Acceptance of Applications for a Certificate of Public Convenience to Operate a Transportation Network Vehicle Service), prescribing the period of Provisional Authority of Transport Network Vehicle Service for Forty Five (45) days;

**WHEREAS**, in order to effectively address the considerable increase in the number of applications for TNVS filed before this office, and in effect, ease the burden of the applicants in filing for the renewal of their Provisional Authority, the Board sees the need to extend the period of validity of the Provisional Authority;

**WHEREFORE**, the **Memorandum Circular No. 2015-017** dated 28 May 2015, particularly letter (C) PROVISIONAL AUTHORITY is hereby amended, extending the period of validity of Provisional Authority for TNVS to a period of Ninety (90) days.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately following its publication in a newspaper of general circulation and the filing of three (3) copies hereof with the UP Law Center pursuant to Presidential Memorandum Circular No. 11, dated 09 October 1992.

*WHEREAS*, one of the powers and functions of Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board under Executive Order No. 202 is to formulate, promulgate, administer, implement, and enforce rules and regulations on land transportation public utilities . . . x x x . . .;

*WHEREAS*, on 28 May 2015, the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2015-017 (Implementing Guidelines on the Acceptance of Applications for a Certificate of Public Convenience to Operate a Transportation Network Vehicle Service), prescribing the period of Provisional Authority of Transport Network Vehicle Service for Forty Five (45) days;


*WHEREAS*, in order to effectively address the considerable increase in the number of applications for TNVS filed before this office, and in effect, ease the burden of the applicants in filing for the renewal of their Provisional Authority, the Board sees the need to extend the period of validity of the Provisional Authority;

*WHEREFORE*, the Memorandum Circular No. 2015-017 dated 28 May 2015, particularly letter (C) PROVISIONAL AUTHORITY is hereby amended, extending the period of validity of Provisional Authority for TNVS to a period of Ninety (90) days.


This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately following its publication in a newspaper of general circulation and the filing of three (3) copies hereof with the UP Law Center pursuant to Presidential Memorandum Circular No. 11, dated 09 October 1992.
