MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 87-008

SUBJECT : DECISIONS PROMULGATED BY THE FORMER LAND  
TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION AUTHORIZING  
METRO-MANILA ROUTES NOT IN ACCORD WITH  
DOTC PLANS.

---

The Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board is flooded with applications pending consideration. Some of these were decided by the defunct LTC but are still unreleased. It was noticed, however, that some routes, as authorized in these decisions, do not conform with the DOTC's route rationalization and standardization plan, which, the LTC and Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board are bound to implement. Pursuant to the DOTC's transport development plans, the Board will have to modify all previously authorized routes in order that they may conform to said plan. In this regard, all decisions which do not conform to the said plan shall be released provided the applicants will consult the Board towards modifying their routes, at their option, which shall be mutually acceptable. Should the applicants fail to exercise their option within one (1) week from receipt of notice to this effect, the Board, motu-proprio, will proceed to modify their routes to the nearest or most approximate routes which shall be in conformity with the DOTC plan.

The Technical Evaluation Division is hereby tasked with preparing amendatory orders as may be necessary in order to effectively implement the DOTC's route rationalization plan.
