MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NUMBER 87-0015

SUBJECT

: DEADLINE FOR SUBSTITUTION OF PHASED-OUT UNITS AND PAYMENT OF EXTENSION FEES

Upon consideration of the request of the President of the Philippine Taxi Operators of the Philippines (PHILTOP) that they be allowed to register good second hand cars in lieu of phased-out units, the Board, after due deliberation and taking into account the scarcity of brand new units or if they are available at all, their cost is prohibitive and considering the plight of taxicab operators, this Board hereby issues the following guidelines in the registration of second hand cars in lieu of phased-out units:

- Phased-out units not registered for taxicab operation for calendar year 1985 under Memorandum Circular No. 85-018 dated June 1, 1985 will be allowed to be substituted upon payment of an extension fee of P 150.00 per Gat/month from January 1, 1986 up to the time the petition for substitution is filed with the Board;
- 2. No petition for substitution will be accepted unless it is accompanied by a certification by the authorized inspector of the Land Transportation Office that the proposed substitute units have been thoroughly subjected to actual and physical inspection, and test and thereafter found to be roadworthy and safe for operation;
- 3. No petition for substitution will be accepted on expired or abandoned certificates of public convenience;
- That all phased-out units must be substituted on or before \_ June 30, 1988; and
- 5. Effective July 1, 1988 all phased-out units not substituted will be cancelled or deducted from the number of authorized units of the Certificate of Public Convenience of the operator.

All Memorandum Circular inconsistent with this memorandum are deemed cancelled/revoked.
