MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NUMBER 89-008

SUBJECT: Additional Markings of Air-Conditioned
Taxis

It has been observed by the Board that Memorandum Circular No. JC-83-007 of the former Board of Transportation was not observed by taxi operators who converted their regular units to air-conditioned units.

To avoid misleading the passengers and to enable the riding public to know and distinguish a regular taxicab from an air-conditioned taxicab, the LTFRB hereby orders:

All taxicabs authorized by the LTFRB to operate as air-conditioned units must have these words painted on both sides prominently in solid black letters: "AIR-CON". [The letters must be 12 cms tall and 8 cms wide].

Operators authorized to operate air-conditioned taxicabs must comply with this rule within thirty (30) days from date.

Failure to comply with this rule will subject the offender to penalty of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) aside from the other penalties provided for in the existing laws and Memorandum Circulars.
