MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

Number 87-018

SUBJECT: PUB and PUU APPLICATIONS FOR ADDITIONAL UNITS AND/OR LINES

To eliminate the practice on the part of holders of certificates of public convenience for the operation of public utility buses and jeepneys of applying for additional units and/or lines when all their authorized units under their certificates have not even been duly registered with the Land Transportation Office, no application for additional units and/or lines will be accepted unless:

- 1) the application states the total number of units authorized under the applicant's valid and subsisting certificates of public convenience and those on the line where the additional units are proposed;
- 2) the application states that all the authorized units have been duly registered with the LTO, indicating the registering LTO agency;
- 3) the application shall be verified and signed by the president or general manager of the corporation or partnership or by the holder of the certificate of public convenience if the applicant is a natural person.

This memorandum circular shall take effect immediately.
