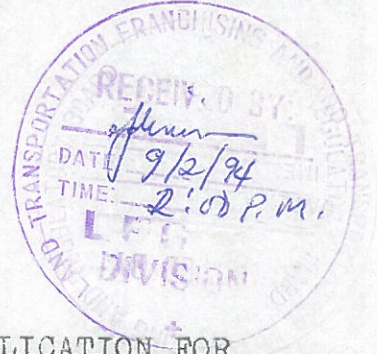

EXTENSION OF VALIDITY OF EXPIRED
CPC.

For the information and guidance of all concerned, the Board has decided that application for extension of validity of expired Certificate of Public Convenience shall no longer be accepted by the Board or by any of its regional offices.

All public utility vehicle operators are, therefore, hereby advised to file their applications for extension of validity of their CPC's on or before the expiration dates of such CPC's.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately.

Any or all issuances inconsistent herewith are hereby superceded and/or revoked.
