MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR 98-010 NUMBER

SUBJECT

PUBLIC UTILITY MINI-BUS

In accordance with Item No. 2 of DOTC Dept. Order No. 97-1097, providing standard classification for all public land-based transport conveyances, applications for franchises to operate "Public Utility Mini-Bus" may propose the use of motor vehicles with the following features:

20-49 excluding driver and 1. Seating Capacity . conductor Between 4,000 and 6,399 2. Gross Vehicle Weight kgs. and/or 70 kgs./pax Mini-coach with entry/exit 3. Body Make door, emergency exits and optional separate baggage compartment.

The routes shall be fixed, regular, limited stop or express with a route ceiling distance of 100 kms. Ventilation may either be ordinary or air-conditioned, and the fare shall be based on distance or zonal as authorized by the LTFRB.

In the meantime, however, in view of the present moratorium on the acceptance of new applications for franchises to operate public utility vehicles, as imposed under Memorandum Circulars No. 97-009 and 97-009-A, only petitions not involving or resulting to additional units shall be accepted for consideration.

This Memorandum Circular takes effect fifteen (15) days after the filing of three (3) copies hereof with the U.P. Law Center, pursuant to Presidential Memorandum Circular No. 11, dated October 9, 1992.
