EXTENSION OF LATE FILING OF EXPIRED CPC

As proposed by various transport groups, the Board hereby extends the period of late filing of expired Certificates of Public Convenience (CPC) covered under Memorandum Circular No. 2005-009 (Re: Acceptance of Petitions/Applications for Extension of Validity of Expired CPC, dated 01 April 2005).

Accordingly, all expired CPC, reckoned from 01 January 2004 and covered under MC No. 2005-009, may be filed for Extension of Validity until 30 September 2005, subject to the provisions set forth therein.

This Memorandum Circular supersedes any and all issuances inconsistent herewith, and takes effect immediately following the filing of three (3) copies hereof with the UP Law Center, pursuant to Presidential Memorandum Circular No. 11, dated 09 October 1992.
