MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NUMBER 2006 - 043

SUBJECT

TURN OVER AND SURRENDER OF YELLOW

PLATES.

In a Joint LTO -LTFRB Memorandum Circular No. 2004-002-J dated 6 August 2004, all PUV operators applying for dropping and substitution of unit/s were directed to directly turn-over and surrender the yellow plates of the unit/s proposed to be dropped to the LTFRB. The concerned LTFRB offices shall then issue the corresponding acknowledgment receipt therefor. All the surrendered yellow plates shall be cut crosswise and lengthwise and thereafter turned over to LTO for final disposition.

In order to reduce the increasing number of vehicles running without plates during the pendency of the approval of the application/s, the yellow plates of the unit/s proposed to be dropped shall now be required to be surrendered to LTFRB once the Order approving the application for Dropping and/or Dropping and Substitution had already been signed by the Board. The applicant shall be properly notified of the approval of the application through a letter sent via registered mail. Also, the applicant shall be required to personally receive the Order and turn over the yellow plates.

This Memorandum Circular supersedes any and all issuances inconsistent herewith and shall be effective fifteen (15) days after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation or in the Official Gazette.
