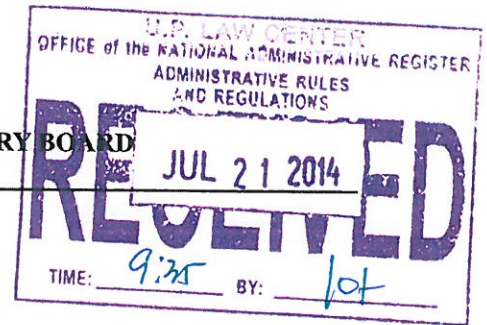

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NUMBER 2014 - 011

Subject: ACCEPTANCE FOR THE FILING OF APPLICATION/PETITION FOR EXEMPTION IN THE OPERATION OF TH FREIGHT TRUCK SERVICES

The issuance of the Joint Administrative Order 2014-01, subject: Revised Schedule of Fines and Penalties for Violations of Laws, Rules and Regulations Governing Land Transportation, which took effect on June 19, 2014, has resulted in the sudden influx of applications for the issuances of a Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC) for TH Freight Truck Services.

In order to clarify and address the concerns of all owners/operators of private vehicles classified as truck, aluminum van and the like which are being exclusively used and in furtherance of the owners' business from being apprehended by the law enforcers with respect to their non-application of a CPC, this Board deems it necessary to **SET ASIDE & REVOKE Memorandum Circular 2009-013** dated June 18, 2009, the 2nd par., which discontinued the filing of Application for Exemption for the Operation of TH Services.

This Memorandum Circular is hereby issued to allow the filing of Application for Exemption for the Operation of TH Services. For the guidance of all concerned, the requirements under Memorandum Circular 2004-043 are hereby adapted and modified in part, which must be submitted in support of the Application for Exemption, to wit:

1. Certificates of Registration and Official Receipts of the units should be in the name of the Applicant/Petitioner;
2. For Corporations – Certificate of Incorporation & Articles of Incorporation duly issued by SEC; For Cooperatives – Certificate of Registration & Articles of Cooperative duly issued by CDA;
3. Valid Business Name duly issued by the Department of Trade and Industry for sole proprietorship;
4. Business Permit/ Mayor's Permit duly issued by the local government unit of the place where the principal business of the Applicant/Petitioner is located;
5. Sales Invoice/Delivery Receipts/Official Receipts in the name of the Applicant/Petitioner to show proof that the goods/products carried by the unit/s is in furtherance of his/her/its own business;

6. Location/branches indicating the address of the place/s where the goods will be brought;
7. Affidavit that the truck is exclusively used and in furtherance of his/her/its own business.

The Technical Division of this Board and its Regional Offices shall assign the Case No. of each application/petition for reference and monitoring purposes. Thereafter, the Legal Division shall calendar the case for hearing in accordance with our rules of practice and procedure.

All other issuances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby modified, amended or superseded accordingly.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately. Let three (3) copies hereof be filed with the UP Law Center, published in a newspaper of general circulation, and posted in conspicuous places in all LTFRB offices nationwide.
