**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR**  
**NUMBER 2015- 099**

**SUBJECT: LIFTING OF THE PROHIBITION OF POLITICAL ADVERTISEMENTS ON PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLES**

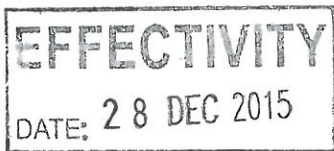
In view of the Decision of the Supreme Court in the case of 1-United Transport Koalisyon (1-UTAK) versus Commission on Elections (G.R. No. 206020, April 14, 2015) which declared null and void Section 7 (g), Items (5) and (6), in relation to Section 7 (f) of Resolution No. 9615 issued by the Commission on Elections, which provides that it is unlawful to post, display or exhibit any election campaign or propaganda materials in public utility vehicles such as buses, jeepneys, trains, taxicabs, ferries, pedicabs, and tricycles, whether motorized or not, this Board hereby amends Memorandum Circular No. 2009-016 (Re: Amendment of Memorandum Circular No. 2007-008 and Related MC's on Transit Advertisement) and Item C, Section III of Memorandum Circular 2013-005 by lifting the prohibition of political advertisements on public utility vehicles. In the processing, approval and issuance of political advertisements on public utility vehicles, the Board and the Regional Offices shall apply Memorandum Circular No. 2013-005 issued by the Board on 30 August 2013 entitled "Standard Requirements and Guidelines in the Processing, approval and Issuance of Permit on Transit Advertisement."

All other issuances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby modified, amended, or superseded accordingly.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately following its publication in a newspaper of general circulation and the filing of three (3) copies hereof with the UP Law Center pursuant to Presidential Memorandum Circular No. 11, dated 09 October 1992.
