**BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 69**  
**Series of 2017**

**WHEREAS**, On June 14, 2017, the Board issued Board Resolution No. 6, Series of 2017 ordering all UV express vans with routes going to and from Davao City going North including but not limited to Davao Oriental, Tagum/ Mati and Compostela Valley and beyond to CEASE AND DESIST from operating their authorized units until further notice from the Board and pending serious and thorough review of their operations and inspection of the PUVs concerned

**WHEREAS**, the Board, in order to ensure the safety and convenience of the riding public on the areas mentioned above, has commenced inspection and tagging of UV Express Services authorize to operate thereat

**WHEREAS**, there is a clamor from the riding public on the mentioned affected areas to allow the operations of UV Express Service which are of roadworthy condition, and whose drivers are faithfully complying with existing traffic rules and regulations;

**WHEREAS**, after due and circumspect deliberation of the issues and circumstances above-stated, taking into account safety measures for public land transportation services vis-à-vis public demand/necessity on the affected areas, the Board has resolved to lift and set aside the Cease and Desist Order, and allow UV Services to operate in the affected areas subject to the conditions set forth hereunder;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Board resolves to LIFT and SET ASIDE the Board Resolution No. 6, Series of 2017, and hereby REINSTATES the authority to operate of UV EXPRESS Services with routes going to and from Davao City going North including but not limited to Davao Oriental, Tagum/ Mati and Compostela Valley, but only insofar as units which have complied with following conditions:

1. Units should have undergone the requisite tagging, as evidenced by LTFRB issued sticker pasted on the windshield of the tagged unit/s;
2. Driver/s of the tagged unit/s should have passed drug testing examination conducted by a drug testing laboratory accredited by Department of Health; and

3. UV Operators concerned should submit Drivers Data Information Sheet at LTFRB Regional Office XI.
