DEPARTMENT ORDER NO. 92-668

Subject: **PHASE-OUT OF OLD MODEL TAXI UNITS**

In the interest of the riding public and for road safety, the phase-out of old model motor vehicles operating as taxi units shall be implemented effective January 1, 1993. Accordingly, the following guidelines shall be adopted:


1. No units below year model 1985 shall be the subject of a new application for the issuance of a Certificate of Public Convenience by the LTRFB;
2. No units below year model 1980 shall be the subject of an application for extension of validity of a Certificate of Public Convenience, and application for sale and transfer of a Certificate of Public Convenience, and application for substitution of units.

The LTO shall inspect and determine the roadworthiness of vehicles by subjecting all taxi units in Metro Manila to the new MVIS effective immediately. Only units that pass the tests, in either the North MVIS in Quezon City or the South MVIS in Pasay City, shall be allowed to renew their registration.

A taxi unfit for public service that is found plying or operating on the road shall be impounded, its corresponding Certificate of Public Convenience or authority cancelled or suspended. Impounded units may be released only after payment of the corresponding fines/penalties.

This Department Order shall take effect on January 1, 1993, and any and all issuances inconsistent herewith are hereby superseded/revoked.
