

BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 063 Series of 2018

(RE: OPENING OF ROUTES IN REGION 6 FOR APPLICATION FOR NEW CPC UNDER THE INITIAL IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLE MODERNIZATION PROGRAM)

WHEREAS, on 19 June 2017, the Department of Transportation (DOTr) issued Department Order No. 2017-011 (Re: Omnibus Guidelines on the Planning and Identification of Public Road Transportation Services and Franchise Issuance) adopting the rules and procedures for the issuance of franchises for public transport routes and services;

WHEREAS, the DOTr has given the LTFRB authority to deliberate and take appropriate action on proposed additional routes pursuant to the Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program (PUVMP) and Memorandum Circular No. 2018-006;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5(a) of Executive Order No. 202, dated June 19, 1987, the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) shall have the power "to prescribe and regulate routes of service, economically viable capacities and zones or areas of operation of public land transportation services provided by motorized vehicles, xxx";

WHEREAS, LTFRB Regional Franchising and Regulatory Office (RFRO) No. 6 conducted a route survey for the initial implementation of the PUVMP for Region 6 to address the passenger demand in new routes towards the socio-economic development of the area and submitted its recommendation to the Board;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, this Board hereby LIFTS the moratorium in the acceptance of Applications for the Issuance of New CPC to Operate PUJ Service subject to the following:

1. Applications for the Issuance of New CPC to Operate PUJ Service and Motions for Issuance of Provisional Authority shall be accepted for processing by the LTFRB RFRO No. 6 on the following new Intra-Provincial routes:

1	Vistamall - Mohon Terminal via Iloilo Circumferential Road 1	8.0 km	15	PUJ

3	Vistamall - Pavia Terminal via F. Gorriceta Jr. Ave.	6.6 km	15	PUJ

2. The intra-provincial route described above, shall be subjected to the results of the Local Public Transport Route Plan (LPTRP) of Iloilo City. All operators

shall, upon filing of their Application, execute an undertaking stating that they will immediately comply with the approved LPTRP of Iloilo City.

3. All Applicants for new CPC on the above-stated new routes shall consolidate under the one route-one operator-one franchise scheme consistent with the Industry Consolidation Component under the PUVMP. Priority shall be accorded to cooperatives/corporations whose business offices are situated near/adjacent to the routes applied for.
4. The Units must be compliant with the vehicle specifications including the required devices/gadgets as prescribed under the OFG and the Philippine National Standards issued by the Department of Trade and Industry.
5. A Provisional Authority may be issued for a period of Forty Five (45) days upon the Acceptance of Application provided that a photocopy of the passenger insurance policy is submitted.

An additional amount of Two Hundred Sixty Pesos (Php 260.00) shall be paid by applicants if they pray for the issuance of PA in the Application or in a separate Motion.
