RESOLUTION NO. 089 Series of 2018

(Re: Acceptance of New Application for New CPC Under the Initial Implementation of the Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program [PUVMP] Under MC No. 2018-013)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Memorandum Circular 2018-013 (Re: Implementing Guidelines in the Acceptance of Applications for New CPC Under the Initial Implementation of the Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program) a Pre-Qualification Committee was constituted to evaluate all applications of new CPC filed before the LTFRB under the initial implementation of the PUVMP;

WHEREAS, on 24 September 2018, the Committee evaluated the Qualification Documents submitted by the following prospective applicants for the route SAN ISIDRO, RODRIGUEZ - BATASAN:

1. COMMON TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE
2. RODRIGUEZ TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE
3. COOPERATIVA RODRIGUEZ DE MONTALBAN TRANSPORT

WHEREAS, the Committee found that COMMON TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE failed to comply with the implementing guidelines set forth under MC No. 2018-013, particularly item no. 6 letter (c) thereof, which provides that applicant must provide a proof of number of units available. The proposed delivery schedule of the units, as certified by the choice of manufacturer of the Applicant, is on the first quarter of 2019. Applicant also failed to comply with item no. 6, letter (d) thereof, which provides that applicant must submit a garage and terminal location as prescribed under OFG or letter of support from property owner. Applicant submitted a Contract of Lease wherein the name of the Lessor indicated was a different person appearing in the attached Transfer of Certificates of Title;

WHEREAS, the Committee found that RODRIGUEZ TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE failed to comply with the implementing guidelines set forth under MC No. 2018-013, particularly item no. 6 letter (c) thereof, which provides that applicant must provide a proof of number of units available. The proposed delivery schedule of the units, as certified by the choice of manufacturer of the Applicant, is 60 working days from the date of issuance of the Notice of Selection signed by this Committee. Applicant also failed to comply with item no. 6, letter (d) thereof, which provides that applicant must submit a garage and terminal location as prescribed under OFG or letter of support from property owner. Applicant submitted a Contract of Lease wherein the name of the Lessor

indicated was a different person appearing in the attached Transfer of Certificate of Title. Also, said proposed garage is not sufficient to accommodate all the authorized units. Furthermore, Applicant failed to submit a proof of designated off-street terminal in Batasan, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the Committee found that COOPERATIVA RODRIGUEZ DE MONTALBAN TRANSPORT failed to comply with the implementing guidelines set forth under MC 2018-013, particularly item no. 6 letter (c) thereof, which provides that applicant must provide a proof of number of units available. Applicant submitted a Quotation for purchase of vehicles only. Applicant also failed to comply with item no. 6, letter (d) thereof, which provides that applicant must submit a garage and terminal location as prescribed under OFG or letter of support from property owner. Applicant failed to submit a proof of its designated off-street terminal in San Isidro, Rodriguez, Rizal;

NOW THEREFORE, this Committee resolves to DENY the herein Applicants Common Transport Service Cooperative, Rodriguez Transport Service Cooperative and Cooperativa Rodriguez De Montalban Transport for failing to comply with the implementing guidelines set forth under MC No. 2018-013.
