WHEREAS, on 27 June 2018, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2018-013 (Re: Implementing Guidelines in the Acceptance of Applications for New CPC Under The Initial Implementation of the Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program) wherein the Board issued the guidelines in the acceptance of New CPC under the initial implementation of the PUVMP for the NCR of PUJ Route of 1.) Eastwood Libis – Capitol Commons via C5, Pasig Shaw Boulevard, Capt. Henry Javier/Hillcrest and 2.) Parañaque Integrated Terminal Exchange (PITX) - Lawton via Macapagal/Seaside, Roxas Boulevard, Anda Circle, Soriano St., and Riverside

WHEREAS, the Board reiterates that the CPCs granted on the above mentioned routes shall be without prejudice to the results of the route rationalization study by the DOTr or the Local Public Transport Route Plan (LPTRP) of the concerned Local Government Unit;

WHEREAS, there is an existing clamor from the said CPC grantees to this Board for modification of route which is in line with the public necessity and convenience with the riding public as well as the viability of the said route to include EDSA Central and Mall of Asia (MOA);

NOW THEREFORE, RESOLVED as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, pursuant to this Board's existing 2011 Rules of Practice and Procedure, the concerned PUJ Operators are directed to file the appropriate pleading for modification of route so this Board can act upon the same.
