**BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 009**  
**Series of 2019**

**WHEREAS**, on 19 June 2017, the Department of Transportation (DOTr) issued Department Order No. 2017-011 (Re: Omnibus Guidelines on the Planning and Identification of Public Road Transportation Services and Franchise Issuance) adopting the rules and procedures for the issuance of franchises for public transport routes and services;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 5(a) of Executive Order No. 202, the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) shall have the power “to prescribe and regulate routes of service, economically viable capacities and zones or areas of operation of public land transportation services provided by motorized vehicles;


**WHEREAS**, in a letter of Vallacar Transit, Inc. dated 14 January 2019, attaching therewith the letter of recommendations from the LGUs and from the Regional Director of LTFRB Region 6, it requested that they may be allowed to file an Amended Application under CPC Nos. BEO-98-VI-205 and 88-VI-920-NOC amending their routes from “Bacolod – Hinobaan via Bayawan to “Bacolod City – Dumaguete City via Mabinay, Dawis, Bayawan City and Vice Versa” or, at the very least, Special Permit from April 1, 2019 until further notice from the Board in order to address the public demand and to augment the inadequacy of units along the above-mentioned route;

**WHEREAS**, a Special Permit had already been granted by the Board to Vallacar Transit, Inc. to operate PUB service on the line Bacolod City – Dumaguete City via Mabinay, Dawis, Bayawan and vice versa;

**WHEREAS**, the Board sees the need to further improve the accessibility of the entire stretch of said route by filling-up the additional transport requirement in the area in order to effectively address the concerns of the riding public;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Board resolves to **GRANT** the request of Vallacar Transit, Inc. to file an Application for the amendment of route particularly under Case Nos. BEO-98-VI-205 and 88-VI-920-NOC from its original route of “Bacolod – Hinobaan via Bayawan to **“Bacolod City – Dumaguete City via Mabinay, Dawis, Bayawan and Vice Versa”**. Meanwhile, pending approval of the proposed amended route, its Special Permit which is set to expire on 31 March 2019 is accordingly extended up to 30 September 2019. Relevant to it, RFROs 6 & 7 are hereby mandated to jointly conduct a transport survey covering the entire road network of Negros Island and to submit a recommendation report within three (3) months from the receipt of this resolution.
