BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 070
SERIES OF 2019

WHEREAS, the Board issued on 13 March 2015, Memorandum Circular No. 2015-008 entitled Guidelines Governing the Issuance of Special Permits;

WHEREAS, the Board also issued on 15 September 2016, Memorandum Circular No. 2016-014 entitled Amendment to Memorandum Circular No. 2015-008;

WHEREAS, the Board also issued on 10 February 2017, Memorandum Circular No. 2017-004 entitled Approving the 2017 LTFRB Citizen's Charter and Mandating Its Primacy Over Inconsistent Provisions of LTFRB Issuances, further amending MC No. 2015-008 and MC 2016-014;

WHEREAS, in the above mentioned MCs, Special Permits for Out-of-Line Trips during Special Occasions or Activities shall be given to units covered by a valid Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC) or that an Extension of Validity has been duly filed;


WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Board that there are holders of Provisional Authority to operate public utility vehicles issued by the Board that are being requested to be used as vehicles for special occasions;

NOW THEREFORE, in order to settle the predicament that only holders of valid CPC are allowed to secure Special Permits for Out-of-Line Trips during Special Occasion or Activities, the Board hereby RESOLVES to grant Special Trips to units with valid Provisional Authority (PA) under the following conditions:

1. This shall apply to all modes of transport service except Truck-for-Hire Service;
2. The proposed unit/s should not be more than ten (10) years old;
3. During Special Holidays (e.g., Holy Week, All Saints' Day, Eidul Fitr and Eidul Adha, Christmas Season, National Elections), applications should be filed at least two (2) weeks prior to the start of the duration of the scheduled travel. For special occasions/activities (e.g. excursions, attendance to seminars, family trip/festivity) applications shall be filed at least two (2) days prior to the intended date of travel. No applications shall be accepted beyond these cut-off dates/schedules;
4. Applications for Special Trips with incomplete required documents shall be denied;
5. All Memorandum Circulars and other related issuances or provisions related on the issuance of Special Permit for Special Trips shall be strictly observed.
