BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 073
SERIES OF 2019

WHEREAS, on February 23, 2016, a Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC) was granted to **Electric Vehicle Expansion Enterprises, Inc. (EVEE-I)** for the use of fifteen (15) electric PUJ units, which CPC is to expire on February 23, 2021;

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation (DOTr) issued Department Order No. 011, Series of 2017, otherwise known as the Omnibus Guidelines on the Planning and Identification of Public Road Transportation Services and Franchise Issuance or the Omnibus Franchising Guidelines (OFG), which aims to provide a reliable, safe, adequate, accessible, environment-friendly, dependable, efficient, and comfortable public road transportation throughout the country;

WHEREAS, the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB), a sectoral agency of the DOTr, is tasked to implement the OFG;

WHEREAS, the LTFRB is empowered, under Section 5 of Executive Order No. 202, to, among others, prescribe and regulate routes of service, and zones or areas of operation of public land transportation services provided by motorized vehicles in accordance with the public land transportation development plans and programs of the DOTr;

WHEREAS, on November 27, 2018, LTFRB-NCR received an Indorsement from OIC-Undersecretary Mark Richmond M. De Leon of DOTr, attaching thereto an Application of EVEE-I to increase its authorized units from fifteen (15) units to twenty five (25) electric PUJ vehicles;

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2018, LTFRB-NCR submitted its recommendation on the increase of units applied for by EVEE-I taking into consideration the PUV Modernization Program and the OFG;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Board hereby **RESOLVES** as it is **RESOLVED** to:

1. **GRANT** the request of **Electric Vehicle Expansion Enterprises, Inc. (EVEE-I)** for increase of units to a total of twenty five (25), all electric-powered vehicles, on the route *within Filinvest City located in Alabang, Muntinlupa City*;
2. **DIRECT** EVEE-I to present the ten (10) additional units for inspection by LTFRB-NCR;
3. **DIRECT** LTFRB-NCR to accept and process the Application for Increase of Units in accordance with existing policies of the Board.
