**BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 195**  
**Series of 2019**

**WHEREAS**, the Board has on 17 March 2017, issued Memorandum Circular No. 2017-006 Re: Amendment to Memorandum Circular No. 2012-022 (Granting Provisional Authority for Trucks – for – Hire Service);

**WHEREAS**, just recently, the Board met with the representatives of the Philippine Economic Zone Authority (PEZA), Department of Trade and Industry and International Finance Corporation (IFC) World Bank and discussed franchising concerns;

**WHEREAS**, raised during the meeting, the limited period of Provisional Authority (90 days) given to truckers by the Board causing delay in the delivery of services such as raw materials, parts, equipment and other goods to the PEZA-registered enterprises, considering that only PEZA-accredited truckers/operators are allowed to operate within PEZA;

**WHEREAS**, the validity of PEZA accreditation given to truckers coincide with the period of authority such as Certificate of Public Convenience or Provisional Authority, thereby restraining the continuous operations of truckers in the area;

**WHEREAS**, there has been an urgent clamor to extend the period of Provisional Authority pending issuance of Certificate of Public Convenience granted to truckers particularly those responsible in the transport, delivery or conveyance of the necessary raw materials, parts, equipment and other goods to the PEZA-registered enterprises;


**NOW THEREFORE**, in order to ensure the continuous and unhampered operations of truckers operating in PEZA, the Board hereby **RESOLVES to extend the period of Provisional Authority (PA)**, particularly to those responsible in the transport, delivery or conveyance of the necessary raw materials, parts, equipment and other goods to the PEZA-registered enterprises **from ninety (90) days to three hundred sixty five (365) days**, counted from date of the PA;

**RESOLVED**, that pre-condition to the issuance of the 365 days Provisional Authority, PEZA must furnish the Board listings its of accredited truckers with plate number of their units and/or truckers with requests for PEZA accreditation with plate number of their units;


**RESOLVED** further, the validity of the issued PA shall be dependent on the outcome/resolution of the pending application for issuance of CPC. The PA shall cease to be valid and effective should the application be dismissed, furnishing copy of the Order to PEZA for the revocation of PEZA accreditation of the operator concerned.

All Memorandum Circulars and other related issuances or provisions related on the issuance of Provisional Authority shall be strictly observed.
