WHEREAS, after a careful and thorough evaluation of the above application and its supporting documents, the Committee found that the applicant failed to submit/provide the following, to wit:

1. Documentary requirements set forth under the Technical Qualifications pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013, to wit:
 - a. Number of compliant units available with OR/CR and undertaking that the remaining units will be made available within three (3) months as certified by the vehicle manufacturer/supplier;
 - b. Undertaking that 25% of the number of required units within three (3) months, 50% within six (6) months, 100% within nine (9) months will be delivered as certified by the vehicle manufacturer/supplier;
 - c. Undertaking that the units shall be compliant with the specifications and standards under OFG and DTI-PNS;
 - d. Fleet Management System with organized vehicle dispatch procedures;
 - e. Copies of Letter of Support from property owners/managers regarding access to, or use of, each off-street loading and unloading area in both endpoints;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, the Committee resolves to recommend to the Board to **DENY** the aforesaid application.
