BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 119
SERIES OF 2019

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation (DOTr) issued Department Order No. 011, Series of 2017, otherwise known as the Omnibus Guidelines on the Planning and Identification of Public Road Transportation Services and Franchise Issuance or the Omnibus Franchising Guidelines (OFG), which aims to provide a reliable, safe, adequate, accessible, environment-friendly, dependable, efficient, and comfortable public road transportation throughout the country;

WHEREAS, the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB), a sectoral agency of the DOTr, is tasked to implement the OFG;

WHEREAS, the DOTr has likewise tasked LTFRB to determine appropriate routes for the PUV Modernization Program (PUVMP) for its initial implementation;

WHEREAS, the LTFRB is empowered, under Section 5 of Executive Order No. 202, to, among others, prescribe and regulate routes of service, and zones or areas of operation of public land transportation services provided by motorized vehicles in accordance with the public land transportation development plans and programs of the DOTr;

WHEREAS, on 23 January 2019, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2019-005 opening the route PITX – Sucat via Sucat Avenue with the use of thirty three (33) Class 2 PUJ units;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements and procedure set forth in said MC, a Notice of Selection was issued on March 1, 2019 in favour of Great Power Movers Transportation Corporation ;

WHEREAS, on May 16, 2019 a Provisional Authority was issued in favour of Great Power Movers Transportation Corporation to ply said route with the use of Thirty three (33) units;

WHEREAS, on May 25, 2019 Great Power Movers Transportation Corporation wrote a letter to clarify the route details from PITX to Sucat, and included therein their proposed amendment on the route from PITX to Sucat;

WHEREAS, upon ocular inspection and evaluation of the proposed route modification, it appears that there is no access from Cavite Expressway going to Victor Medina Road. Said road is accessible only from Sucat going to PITX but not on the return route;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the Board hereby RESOLVES as it is RESOLVED to **GRANT** the request of Great Power Movers Transportation Corp. to **AMEND the route details from PITX to SUCAT via Sucat Road.**

Accordingly, the route description from PITX to SUCAT via Sucat Road is hereby amended as follows :

From : PITX – SUCAT via Sucat Avenue


Diosdado Macapagal Boulevard, Pacific Avenue, Cavite Expressway, Victor Medina Road, Paranaque – Sucat Road to Dr Acadio Santos Avenue (Sucat)

To : PITX – SUCAT via Sucat Avenue

Diosdado Macapagal Boulevard, Seaside Drive, NAIA Road, Ninoy Aquino Avenue, Arcadio Santos Avenue, Meralo Road, Sucat Jeepney Terminal

The original route description from Sucat to PITX stands.
