



RESOLUTION NO. 140 Series of 2019

(Re: Opening of Applications for the Issuance of New CPC under the PUVMP as approved during the 11th LTFRB Board Meeting – Application of MAKABAYAN AKTIBONG PAMPUBLIKONG SASAKYAN [MAPS], INC.)

WHEREAS, before this Committee is the application of MAKABAYAN AKTIBONG PAMPUBLIKONG SASAKYAN [MAPS], INC. for the RODRIGUEZ (SUB-URBAN) – NORTH EDSA route under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-024.

WHEREAS, after a careful and thorough evaluation of the above application and its supporting documents, the Committee found that the applicant failed to submit/provide the following, to wit:

1. Undertaking that the remaining units will be made available within three (3) months as certified by the vehicle manufacturer/supplier, undertaking that 25% of the number of required units within three (3) months, 50% within six (6) months, 100% within nine (9) months will be delivered as certified by the vehicle manufacturer/supplier, undertaking that the units shall be compliant with the specifications and standards under OFG and DTI-PNS, undertaking that MAKABAYAN AKTIBONG PAMPUBLIKONG SASAKYAN [MAPS], INC. will immediately comply with the approved rationalization study, and Copies of Letter of Support from property owners/managers regarding access to, or use of, each off-street loading and unloading area in the route map as required in the Technical Qualifications under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013;
2. Manner of acquisition for the complaint PUV units identifying the funding source and with detailed financing plan, proof/s of support from funding source as required in the Financial Capability Qualifications under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013.

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, the Committee resolves to recommend to the Board to **DENY** the aforesaid application.
