**RESOLUTION NO. 178 Series of 2019**

(Re: Opening of Applications for the Issuance of New CPC under the initial implementation of the PUVMP as approved during the 8<sup>th</sup> LTFRB Board Meeting – Application of ASSOCIATED CHAPTERS DEVELOPMENT AND TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE)

**WHEREAS**, before this Committee is the application of ASSOCIATED CHAPTERS DEVELOPMENT AND TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE for the SILANGAN, SAN MATEO, RIZAL - CUBAO route under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-022.

**WHEREAS**, on 3, 6 and 13 of June 2019, Eastern Villagers Multi-Purpose Cooperative and AFP Housing Operators and Drivers Association filed a duly notarized Letters of Opposition addressed to LTFRB Chairman, Atty. Martin B. Delgra III and OIC-Undersecretary for Road Transport and Infrastructure, Mr. Mark Richmond M. De Leon regarding the opening of the Silangan, San Mateo, Rizal to Cubao route under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-022.

**WHEREAS**, on 10 July 2019, the 2nd Qualification Committee issued a Resolution Numbered 166 series of 2019, wherein the committee resolved:

**“NOW THEREFORE**, premises considered, this Committee hereby resolves to respectfully **ENDORSE** to the Board the filed Letters of Opposition from Eastern Villagers Multi-Purpose Cooperative and AFP Housing Operators and Drivers Association for deliberation and appropriate action.”

**WHEREAS**, after a careful and thorough evaluation of the above application and its supporting documents, the Committee found that the applicant failed to submit/provide the following, to wit:

1. Original or Certified True Copies of the Certificate of Registration, Articles and By-Laws, latest Cooperative Annual Performance Report (CARP) duly issued by the Cooperative Development Authority (CDA) and Certificate of Accreditation issued by the Office of Transportation Cooperative (OTC) as required in the Legal Qualifications under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013;
2. Original or Certified True Copies of the following, to wit:
  - a. Undertaking that 25% of the number of required units within three (3) months, 50% within six (6) months, 100% within nine (9) months will be delivered as certified by the vehicle manufacturer/supplier;
  - b. Undertaking that the units shall be compliant with the specifications and standards under OFG and DTI-PNS;
  - c. Undertaking that applicant will comply with the approved DOTrationalization study or LPTRP;

- d. Fleet Management System with organized vehicle dispatch procedures;
  - e. Evidence of formal arrangement with Automatic Fare Collection (AFC) service provider that will offer inter-operable AFC service that is fully compliant with fare media related technical specifications as determined by LTFRB.
3. Copies of Letter of Support from property owners/managers regarding access to, or use of, each off-street loading and unloading area in both endpoints;
  4. Transfer Certificate of Title to support its submitted Contract of Lease regarding its proposed garage/depot space pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 2017-027;
  5. Original or Certified True Copies of the submitted latest Audited Financial Statement and duly stamped "received" by the Bureau of Internal Revenue or its Authorized Agent Banks;
  6. Manner of acquisition for the compliant PUV units identifying the funding source and with detailed financing plan when applicable, proof/s of support from funding source;
  7. Proof of financial capability of at least equal to the set-aside bank deposit, duly certified by the depository bank, and fifty thousand pesos (Php 50,000.00) for UV/Public Utility Jitney services per unit, multiplied by the total number of vehicles for the route that the Applicant-Operator is applying for;
  8. Financial projections for the first five (5) years of operations.

**NOW THEREFORE**, premises considered, in view of the above findings, the Committee resolves to recommend to the Board to **DENY** the aforesaid application.
