RESOLUTION NO. 181 Series of 2019

(Re: Opening of Applications for the Issuance of New CPC under the initial implementation of the PUVMP as approved during the 8th LTFRB Board Meeting – Application of SILANGAN TSC [SILTRANSCO])

WHEREAS, before this Committee is the application of SILANGAN TSC (SILTRANSCO) for the SILANGAN, SAN MATEO, RIZAL - CUBAO route under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-022.

WHEREAS, on 3, 6 and 13 of June 2019, Eastern Villagers Multi-Purpose Cooperative and AFP Housing Operators and Drivers Association filed a duly notarized Letters of Opposition addressed to LTFRB Chairman, Atty. Martin B. Delgra III and OIC-Undersecretary for Road Transport and Infrastructure, Mr. Mark Richmond M. De Leon regarding the opening of the Silangan, San Mateo, Rizal to Cubao route in Memorandum Circular No. 2019-022.

WHEREAS, on 10 July 2019, the 2nd Qualification Committee issued a Resolution Numbered 166 series of 2019, wherein the committee resolved:

“NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, this Committee hereby resolves to respectfully **ENDORSE** to the Board the filed Letters of Opposition from Eastern Villagers Multi-Purpose Cooperative and AFP Housing Operators and Drivers Association for deliberation and appropriate action.”

WHEREAS, after a careful and thorough evaluation of the above application and its supporting documents, the Committee found that the applicant failed to submit/provide the following, to wit:

1. All documentary requirements set forth under the Technical Qualifications pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013 (i.e. Letter of Support for Cubao Terminal is not submitted) and;
2. Manner of acquisition for the compliant PUV units identifying the funding source and with detailed financing plan, proof/s of support from funding sources and Proof of financial capability of at least equal to the set-aside bank deposit, duly certified by the depository bank, which is equivalent to fifty thousand peso (Php 50,000.00) for UV Express Service per unit, multiplied by the total number of vehicles for the route that the Applicant-Operator is applying for as required under the Financial Capability Qualifications pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013.

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, the Committee resolves to recommend to the Board to **DENY** the aforesaid application.
