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**RESOLUTION NO. 188 Series of 2019**

(Re: Opening of Public Utility Vehicle (PUV) routes for the Parañaque Integrated Terminal Exchange (PITX) and Augmentation of existing PUVs serving the terminal – Application of METROEXPRESS CONNECT, INC.)

**WHEREAS**, on 23 January 2019, this Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2019-005 for the opening of the PITX - TANZA route with the use of Class 2 PUJ relative to the implementation of the Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program;

**WHEREAS**, on 15 March 2019, this Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013 to implement the consolidated guidelines on the process of Issuance of Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC) and Provisional Authority (PA)/Special Permit (SP) under the Omnibus Franchising Guidelines & Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program (PUVMP);

**WHEREAS**, on 3 July 2019, the Main Qualification Committee issued Resolution numbered 158 series of 2019 wherein the Committee resolved:


**“NOW THEREFORE**, premises considered, appearing that the filed letter for reconsideration of recommendation and attached Certification from MWM Terminals, Inc. is meritorious, the Committee resolves to **LIFT AND SET-ASIDE** the issued Resolution No. 88 series of 2019 and further recommend to the Board to **RE-AWARD** the PITX - TANZA route in favor of **METROEXPRESS CONNECT, INC.**”

**NOW THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, this Board hereby **ADOPTS** the recommendation of the Main Qualification Committee, let the **PITX - TANZA** route be **AWARDED** and a Notice of Selection be **ISSUED** to **METROEXPRESS CONNECT, INC.**
