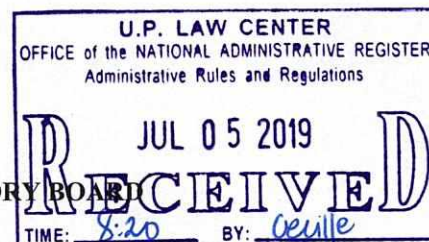

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NUMBER 2019- 030

SUBJECT: OPENING OF APPLICATIONS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF NEW CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE (CPC) TO OPERATE P2P ROUTES ORIGINATING FROM SANGLEY POINT AIRPORT

WHEREAS, on 19 June 2017, the Department of Transportation (DOTr) issued Department Order No. 2017-011 (Re: Omnibus Guidelines on the Planning and Identification of the Public Road Transportation Services and Franchise Issuance) adopting the rules and procedures for the issuance of franchises for public transport routes and services;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5(a) of Executive Order No. 202, dated June 19, 1987, the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) shall have the power “to prescribe and regulate routes of service, economically viable capacities and zones or areas of operation of public land transportation services provided by motorized vehicles, xxxxx”;

WHEREAS, the DOTr has given LTFRB the authority to deliberate and take appropriate action on proposed new/ additional routes pursuant to Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program (PUVMP);

WHEREAS, in response to the directive of President Rodrigo R. Duterte for the immediate opening and operation of the Sangley Point Airport in Cavite, the Department of Transportation, thru Usec. Mark Richmond M. De Leon issued Memorandum dated 14 June 2019 authorizing the opening of P2P route to ensure the provision of public transportation services for the Sangley Airport;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, the following Routes Survey Information are hereby approved for the issuance of New CPCs:

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Only those units that are compliant with the OFG and DTI-PNS standards shall be accepted.

Each route will be awarded to only one (1) qualified Applicant and subsequently processed for the grant of CPC following the provisions of Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013 also known as the Consolidated Guidelines on the Process of Issuance of Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC) and Provisional Authority (PA)/Special Permit (SP) under the Omnibus Franchising Guidelines & Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program (PUVMP) dated 15 March 2019.

Pre- Qualification Conferences shall be held at the Central Office on July 12, 2019, 2:00 p.m.

The deadline for the submission of Letter of Intent and qualification documents will be at 9:00 am of **26 July 2019** to be submitted at the Office of the Executive Director-Central Office. Opening of the sealed documents will immediately follow at 10:00 am of the same date.

In case of failure on the initial qualification process, interested applicants shall be given ten (10) working days from **26 July 2019** to file their Letter of intent and qualification documents.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately following its publication in a newspaper of general circulation and the filing of three (3) copies hereof with the UP Law Center pursuant to Presidential Memorandum Circular No. 11, dated 09 October 1992.

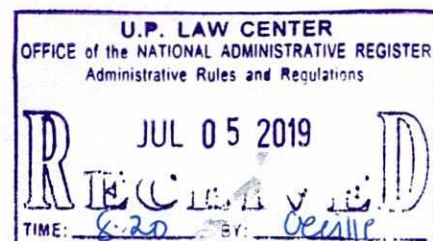
