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**BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 203**  
**Series of 2019**

**WHEREAS**, on 12 February 2018, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2018-005, increasing the common supply base for Metro Manila (including MUCEP area) to Sixty Five Thousand (65,000) TNVS units;

**WHEREAS**, due to the increased volume of transactions in this office, aggravated by the forced lay-off of about 50% Job Order personnel (typist) caused by the re-enactment of National Budget of the office, the backlogs in the typing of Provisional Authority, Decisions, and Dismissal Orders have considerably multiplied;

**WHEREAS**, the existing situation of backlogs require urgent solution in order to correspond promptly with the needs and demands of our stakeholders;

**WHEREAS**, one of the immediate solution proposed to lessen the backlogs of pending applications/petitions and motions is for the stamping of ninety (90) or thirty (30) day Provisional Authority to operate for TNVS in the applicant's received copy of Application (for applicants initial issuance of PA), and Motion (for applicants with previously issued PA), instead of the previous practice of typing and issuance of provisional authority to operate TNVS;

**NOW THEREFORE**, this Board resolves as it is hereby resolved to allow and authorize the stamping of Provisional Authority to operate for TNVS in the applicants' received copy of Application subject to the following guidelines:

1. QUALIFIED FOR 90 DAY VALIDITY PERIOD

- A. Those who filed Application for Issuance of Certificate of Public Convenience to Operate TNVS starting March 2019 and onwards. (Those who filed on January to February 2019 may have PA already issued, thus, they need to secure a Transmittal Number only for the release of issued PA. The list of PAs ready for release will be posted online via FB page and/or agency website);
- B. Those who have submitted their Formal Offer of Evidence and still pending for resolution.
- C. Those whose applications are still set for hearing;
- D. Those whose applications with expired Provisional Authority but with filed Motion for Extension of PA, provided they belong to any of those enumerated in the preceding paragraphs (par. A, B & C);

2. QUALIFIED FOR 30 DAY VALIDITY OF PA

- A. Those whose application is subject for dismissal or in the list "for dismissal", or those with Dismissal Order but not yet issued/published.

An Office Order will subsequently be issued authorizing only regular/permanent employees to do the stamping of provisional authority.
