BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 204
Series of 2019

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes the large demand for transport services and in response to the present commuters' need, a new kind of Transport Network Vehicle Service (TNVS) was introduced to the commuting public by virtue of Department Order 2015-011 entitled: Further Amending Department Order No. 97-1097 to Promote Mobility, which was initially implemented through our Memorandum Circular 2015-017A entitled, "Implementing Guidelines on the Acceptance of Applications for a Certificate of Public Convenience to Operate a Transport Network Vehicle Service, as amended";

WHEREAS, on 10 December 2018, due to the low turn-out of applications for a Certificate of Public Convenience to operate a TNVS units included in the master list submitted by the TNCs, the Board decided to set a deadline to file their application until 15 December 2018, thereafter, the acceptance of application was considered closed;

WHEREAS, on 17 December 2018, the Board decided to open again the on-line registration for Twenty Thousand (20,000) units, the acceptance of the application started on January 03, 2019. This Board hereby resolves, as it is hereby resolved for the official closure of the acceptance of applications under the 20,000 available slots effective on June 07, 2019. The applicants who failed to file their application despite their on-line registration may apply for another on-line registration for the next opening of TNVS.

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2019, the Board open again the on-line registration for ten thousand (10,000) units per Board Resolution No. 104 Series of 2019. The acceptance of the application started last June 20, 2019.

WHEREAS, after a thorough review of the pertinent data and report of the status of all applications of TNVS, the Board hereby unanimously approved to open again the on-line registration so as to reach the sixty-five (65,000) cap for TNVS pursuant to Memorandum Circular 2018-005. Accordingly, these shall cover applicants with the proposed coverage area of Metro Manila including peripheral areas (MUCEP area) to be filed in the Central Office.

WHEREAS, the implementing guidelines for the acceptance of applications under Memorandum Circular 2015-017-A and the existing rules and policies shall likewise be observed;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board **RESOLVED** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to open additional five thousand (5,000) slots/units for TNVS starting 29 July 2019.


The procedure for application shall be as follows:


1. Open the link that will be provided via LTFRB Website and Facebook Account;
2. Enroll or register on-line provided by the system with complete details and information;
3. The scheduled date and documentary requirements for filing the application will be provided to the applicant via on line.

The following guidelines shall likewise be observed:

1. Only those with complete details and information submitted via on-line registration will be allowed acceptance for filing of the application;
2. The unit subject of application must not be more than three (3) years old;
3. Only the applicant is allowed to file. If the applicant is not available, the direct ascendant/descendant or Spouse is allowed provided that a Special Power of Attorney (SPA) is presented together with a photocopy of a government valid issued ID;
4. Provisional Authority (PA) will be issued only to the Applicant/s with complete requirements.
