RESOLUTION NO. 210 Series of 2019

(Re: Compliance of Guardians Police Bantay Pamilya Transport Cooperative [GPBTC] on Resolution No. 156 series of 2019)

WHEREAS, on 3 July 2019, the Qualification Committee issued resolution numbered 156 series of 2019 wherein the Committee resolved:

- “
1. **GRANT** the Motion for Reconsideration and Motion for Cancellations of Guardian as it established with merit the allegations contained thereat, and **SET ASIDE** Resolution No. 087 Series of 2019 dated May 15, 2019;
 2. **DIRECT** Guardian to submit on or before July 10, 2019 an Undertaking that it will comply with the technical requirement of Certification or Letter of Support from PITX Allowing Guardian to use PITX as its endpoint terminal within the period prescribe hereunder; and
 3. For Guardian to submit not later than July 31, 2019 the required Certification or Letter of Support from PITX Allowing Guardian to use PITX as its endpoint terminal, otherwise, this Resolution shall be **NULLIFIED** and Resolution No. 087 Series of 2019 dated May 15, 2019 shall be **REINSTATED**;
 4. The processing of Application for Issuance of Certificate of Public Convenience to Operate UV Express Service on the routes Brgy. Paliparan, Dasmariñas, Cavite to PITX, and Molino, Bacoor, Cavite to PITX to operate Utility Vehicle Express Service pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 2018-027 shall be allowed only upon full compliance of the documentary requirements. ”

WHEREAS, on 9 July 2019, Guardians Police Bantay Pamilya Transport Cooperative submitted its notarized “Deed of Undertaking” to the Office of the Executive Director in compliance with Item No. 2 of resolution no. 156 series of 2019;

WHEREAS, on 12 July 2019, Guardians Police Bantay Pamilya Transport Cooperative submitted its two (2) copies of Certification from MWM Terminals signed by its General Manager - Mariano Antonio Arroyo, Jr. with Reference Nos. CERTOPTNS-2019-48 and CERTOPTNS-2019-49 dated 10 July 2019 which shows that MWM Terminals has provided slots in the loading and unloading bays of PITX to Guardians Police Bantay Pamilya Transport Cooperative for the cooperative’s twenty-one (21) UV Express units for the route PITX to Brgy. Paliparan, Dasmariñas, Cavite and twenty-eight (28) UV Express units for the route PITX to Molino, Bacoor, Cavite;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, this Committee hereby recommends to the Board to **RE-ISSUE** a formal **NOTICE OF SELECTION** in favor of Guardians Police Bantay Pamilya Transport Service Cooperative on the BRGY. PALIPARAN, DASMARIÑAS, CAVITE TO PITX VIA MOLINO and MOLINO, BACOR, CAVITE TO PITX routes.
