BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 216
Series of 2019

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 202 dated 19 June 1987 Section 5 (c) empowers this Board *“To determine, prescribe and approve and periodically review and adjust, reasonable fares, rates and other related charges, relative to the operation of public land transportation services provided by motorized vehicles”*;

WHEREAS, the Board granted Certificate of Public Conveniences to several electric jeepney operators particularly South Metro Transport Cooperative *plying Alabang – Zapote via old Manila South Road*, Great Power Movers Transportation Corporation *plying PITX – Sucat via Sucat Avenue* and EcoPUV Transport Incorporated *plying Alabang Town Center (ATC) loop*;


WHEREAS, the above mentioned electric jeepney operators recently requested and prayed for a fare adjustment citing their compliances to the mandatory modernization program of the government which requires them to incur a monthly maintenance cost;

WHEREAS, on 17 February 2017 the Board issued an Order in favor of Electric Vehicle Expansion Enterprises Inc. which sets the fare at Eleven Pesos (P 11.00) for the first four (4) kilometers and One Peso (P 1.00) for every succeeding kilometer;

WHEREAS, on 4 June 2019 the Regional Director of LTFRB - National Capital Region recommended to the Board that the same rate be adopted for reason of consistency across all electric jeepney operators;

NOW THEREFORE, this Board resolves as it is hereby resolve authorizes **South Metro Transport Cooperative, Great Power Movers Transportation Corporation and EcoPUV Transport Incorporated to charge Eleven Pesos (P 11.00) for the first four (4) kilometers** while the One Peso (P 1.00) for the succeeding kilometers remains unchanged.
