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**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR**  
NUMBER 2019 - 033

**SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO PACKAGE 14 OF MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 2019-010**

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**WHEREAS**, on 5 March 2019, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2019-010, entitled "Implementing Guidelines On the Opening of Proposed Additional Premium Point-to-Point Bus Services";

**WHEREAS**, paragraph II of the said MC provides that, "Each package will be awarded to one (1) qualified Applicant;

**WHEREAS**, after the selection process, RRCG Transport System Co, Inc. and ALPS the Bus, Inc. were both selected by the LTFRB Qualification Committee as the highest-ranked applicants for Package 14 of LTFRB Memorandum Circular No. 2019-010 that includes the routes of Batangas City to Ortigas and Batangas City to Parañaque Integrated terminal Exchange ;

**WHEREAS**, the parties submitted a Memorandum of Agreement dated 17 June 2019 agreeing among others that **RRCG Transport System Co, Inc.** will apply and proceed with the CPC Application for the route **BATANGAS CITY to PITX** to operate PUB services, while **ALPS THE BUS, INC.** chose to apply and proceed with the CPC Application for the route of **BATANGAS CITY to ORTIGAS** to operate PUB services;

**WHEREAS**, being the declared highest-ranked applicants for Package 14 of the above-mentioned MC, and there being no rights will be prejudiced, the Board affirms the intention of the parties with the understanding that it will promote a better public transport service and harmonious environment among transport operators;

**NOW THEREFORE**, premises considered, the Board hereby **AMENDS** Package 14 of Memorandum Circular No. 2019-010, thus, segregating the routes of Batangas City to Ortigas and Batangas City to Parañaque Integrated terminal Exchange in the package, which shall now be considered as separate packages to be described as follows:

**Package 14-1 :**        **Batangas City to Ortigas**, which route is awarded to ALPS THE BUS, INC.

**Package 14-2 :**        **Batangas City to Parañaque Integrated terminal Exchange**, which route is awarded to RRCG Transport System Co., Inc.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately following its publication in a newspaper of general circulation and the filing of three (3) copies hereof with the U.P. Law Center pursuant to Presidential Memorandum Circular No. 11 dated 09 October 1992.

**SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO PACKAGE 14 OF MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 2019-010**

WHEREAS, on 5 March 2019, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2019-010, entitled "Implementing Guidelines On the Opening of Proposed Additional Premium Point-to-Point Bus Services";

WHEREAS, paragraph II of the said MC provides that, "Each package will be awarded to one (1) qualified Applicant;

WHEREAS, after the selection process, RRCG Transport System Co, Inc. and ALPS the Bus, Inc. were both selected by the LTFRB Qualification Committee as the highest-ranked applicants for Package 14 of LTFRB Memorandum Circular No. 2019-010 that includes the routes of Batangas City to Ortigas and Batangas City to Parañaque Integrated terminal Exchange;

WHEREAS, the parties submitted a Memorandum of Agreement dated 17 June 2019 agreeing among others that RRCG Transport System Co, Inc. will apply and proceed with the CPC Application for the route **BATANGAS CITY to PITX** to operate PUB services, while **ALPS THE BUS, INC.** chose to apply and proceed with the CPC Application for the route of **BATANGAS CITY to ORTIGAS** to operate PUB services;

WHEREAS, being the declared highest-ranked applicants for Package 14 of the above-mentioned MC, and there being no rights will be prejudiced, the Board affirms the intention of the parties with the understanding that it will promote a better public transport service and harmonious environment among transport operators;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, the Board hereby **AMENDS** Package 14 of Memorandum Circular No. 2019-010, thus, segregating the routes of Batangas City to Ortigas and Batangas City to Parañaque Integrated terminal Exchange in the package, which shall now be considered as separate packages to be described as follows:


**Package 14-1:** Batangas City to Ortigas, which route is awarded to **ALPS THE BUS, INC.**

**Package 14-2:** Batangas City to Parañaque Integrated terminal Exchange, which route is awarded to **RRCG Transport System Co., Inc.**

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately following its publication in a newspaper of general circulation and the filing of three (3) copies hereof with the U.P. Law Center pursuant to Presidential Memorandum Circular No. 11 dated 09 October 1992.


