RESOLUTION NO. 228 Series of 2019

(Re: Memorandum Circular No. 2019-039: Opening of Applications for the Issuance of New Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC) under the initial implementation of the Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program approved during the 18th Board Meeting – applications on the route: FAIRVIEW TERRACES - BAGUMBONG VIA CALOOCAN SPORTS COMPLEX)

WHEREAS, before this Committee are the applications of the following, to wit:

1. EASYWAY TRANSPORT SERVICE AND MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE,
2. NOVADECI TRANSPORT SERVICE; and
3. TRIBE OPERATOR'S TRANSPORT SERVICE AND MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE;

for the FAIRVIEW TERRACES - BAGUMBONG VIA CALOOCAN SPORTS COMPLEX route with the use of fifteen (15) authorized Class 2 PUJ units, under the initial qualification process on 27 August 2019 pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 2019-039;

WHEREAS, the committee found that the applicant EASYWAY TRANSPORT SERVICE AND MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE submitted a copy of its letter of support from SM City Fairview (SM Mall) regarding off-street loading and unloading area, not from Fairview Terraces (Ayala Mall);

WHEREAS, the committee found that the applicant NOVADECI TRANSPORT SERVICE failed to submit/provide the following documentary requirements set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013, to wit:

1. Undertaking that the units shall be compliant with the specifications and standards under OFG and DTI-PNS;
2. Undertaking that NOVADECI TRANSPORT SERVICE will immediately comply with the approved rationalization study;
3. Fleet Management System with organized vehicle dispatch procedures;
4. Evidence of formal arrangement with Automatic Fare Collection (AFC) service provider that will offer inter-operable AFC service that is fully compliant with fare media related technical specifications;
5. Copies of Letter of Support from property owners/managers regarding access to, or use of, each off-street loading and unloading area in both endpoints;
6. Proposed garage/depot space pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 2017-027;
7. Manner of acquisition for the compliant PUV units identifying the funding source and with detailed financing plan/proof/s of support from funding source;

8. Proof of financial capability of at least equal to the set-aside bank deposit, duly certified by the depository bank, which is equivalent to fifty thousand pesos (Php 50,000.00) for Public Utility Jitney service per unit, multiplied by the total number of vehicles for the route that the Applicant-Operator is applying for;
9. Projected demand in its financial projections for the first five (5) years of operations.

WHEREAS, NOVADECI TRANSPORT SERVICE submitted an undertaking made by the manufacturer for the delivery of the required units and only good for four (4) months;

WHEREAS, the committee found that the applicant TRIBE OPERATOR'S TRANSPORT SERVICE AND MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE failed to submit/provide the following documentary requirements set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013, to wit:

1. Letter of Intent;
2. Undertaking that TRIBE OPERATOR'S TRANSPORT SERVICE AND MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE will immediately comply with the approved rationalization study;
3. Evidence of formal arrangement with Automatic Fare Collection (AFC) service provider that will offer inter-operable AFC service that is fully compliant with fare media related technical specifications;
4. Copies of Letter of Support from property owners/managers regarding access to, or use of, each off-street loading and unloading area in both endpoints;
5. Original or Certified True Copy of the latest Audited Financial Statement and duly stamped "received" by the BIR or its Authorized Agent Banks;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, this Committee resolves to recommend to the Board to **DENY** the applications of EASYWAY TRANSPORT SERVICE AND MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE, NOVADECI TRANSPORT SERVICE and TRIBE OPERATOR'S TRANSPORT SERVICE AND MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE for failing to comply with the provisions set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013;
