RESOLUTION NO. 230 Series of 2019

(Re: Memorandum Circular No. 2019-039: Opening of Applications for the Issuance of New Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC) under the initial implementation of the Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program approved during the 18th Board Meeting – applications on the route: SOLANO, NUEVA VIZCAYA - METRO MANILA)

WHEREAS, before this Committee are the applications of the following, to wit:

1. NUEVA VIZCAYA TRANSPORT COOP.
2. FIRST NOVO VIZCAYANO TRAVELERS
3. BEE LINER EXPRESS CORP.
4. PANGASINAN FIVE STAR BUS
5. EAGLESTAR TRANSPORT CORP.

for the **SOLANO, NUEVA VIZCAYA - METRO MANILA** route with the use of twenty (20) authorized provincial bus units, under the initial qualification process on 27 August 2019 pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 2019-039;

WHEREAS, the committee found that the applicant NUEVA VIZCAYA TRANSPORT COOP. failed to submit/provide a copy of its Transfer Certificate of Title numbered 125595 supporting the submitted Affidavit of Support from Marlyn S. Ongto for the Solano endpoint;

WHEREAS, the committee found that the applicant FIRST NOVO VIZCAYANO TRAVELERS failed to submit/provide one (1) set of original copies of its qualification documents which is set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013;

WHEREAS, the committee found that the applicant BEE LINER EXPRESS CORP. failed to submit/provide its latest General Information Sheet duly received/issued by the Securities and Exchange Commission but has attached its affidavit that the subject applicant is a newly incorporated entity;

WHEREAS, the committee found that the applicant PANGASINAN FIVE STAR BUS CO. INC. has fully complied with the documentary requirements under Legal, Technical and Financial Capability set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013, thus, rated as **“QUALIFIED”**;

WHEREAS, the committee found that the applicant EAGLESTAR TRANSPORT CORP. submitted its undertaking for the location of its terminal in Solano endpoint but no submission of a copy of its Transfer Certificate of Title, also, the applicant submitted its undertaking and Contract of Lease between the EAGLESTAR TRANSPORT CORP. and Rosang Vine Dev. Corp. for the location of its terminal in Metro Manila endpoint (Dimasalang St., Sta. Cruz, Manila) but no submission of a copy of its Transfer Certificate of Title;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, this Committee resolves to recommend to the Board to:

1. **DENY** the applications of the following for failing to comply with the provisions set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013:
 - a. **NUEVA VIZCAYA TRANSPORT COOP.**, for failure to copy of its Transfer Certificate of Title numbered 125595 supporting the submitted Affidavit of Support from Marlyn S. Ongto for the Solano endpoint;
 - b. **FIRST NOVO VIZCAYANO TRAVELERS**, for failure to submit/provide one (1) set of original copies of its qualification documents;
 - c. **BEE LINER EXPRESS CORP.**, for failure to submit/provide its latest General Information Sheet duly received/issued by the Securities and Exchange Commission;
 - d. **EAGLESTAR TRANSPORT CORP.**, for failure to submit/provide its copies of Transfer Certificate of Title to support its submitted undertaking for the Solano endpoint and for its submitted undertaking and Contract of Lease between EAGLESTAR TRANSPORT CORP. and Rosang Vine Dev. Corp. for the location of its terminal in Metro Manila endpoint (Dimasalang St., Sta. Cruz, Manila);
2. **AWARD** the SOLANO, NUEVA VIZCAYA - METRO MANILA route in favor of **PANGASINAN FIVE STAR BUS CO. INC.**
