**RESOLUTION NO. 234 Series of 2019**

(Re: RE-OPENING OF PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLE ROUTES for the Parañaque Integrated Terminal Exchange (PITX) and augmentation of existing PUVs serving the terminal – applications on the route: PITX - INDANG)

**WHEREAS**, before this Committee are the applications of DON ALDRIN TRANSPORT INC. and ACB TRANSPORT SERVICES, INC. for PITX - INDANG route with the use of thirty-five (35) authorized PUB units, under the selection/qualification process on 9 September 2019 pursuant to Resolution No. 218 series of 2019;

**WHEREAS**, DON ALDRIN TRANSPORT INC. were given a rating of **“PASSED/QUALIFIED”** as it fully complied with the Qualification Requirements - Legal, Technical and Financial Capability Qualifications provided under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee found that ACB TRANSPORT SERVICES, INC. failed to submit/provide the following documentary requirements set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013, to wit:

1. Undertaking that the units shall be compliant with the specifications and standards under OFG and DTI-PNS;
2. Undertaking that the applicant will immediately comply with the approved LPTRP/DOTr rationalization study;
3. Fleet Management System with organized vehicle dispatch procedures;
4. Evidence of formal arrangement with Automatic Fare Collection (AFC) service provider that will offer inter-operable AFC service that is fully compliant with fare media related technical specifications
5. Original or Certified True Copy of the latest Audited Financial Statement and duly stamped “received” by the BIR or its authorized agent banks;

**NOW THEREFORE**, premises considered, this Committee resolves to recommend to the Board to:

1. **DENY** the application of ACB TRANSPORT SERVICES, INC. for failing to comply with the requirements set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013.
2. **AWARD** the PITX - INDANG route in favor of **DON ALDRIN TRANSPORT INC.**
