RESOLUTION NO. 235 Series of 2019

(Re: RE-OPENING OF PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLE ROUTES for the Parañaque Integrated Terminal Exchange (PITX) and augmentation of existing PUVs serving the terminal – applications on the route: PITX - MANGGAHAN, GENERAL TRIAS)

WHEREAS, before this Committee are the applications of the following, to wit:

1. DON ALDRIN TRANSPORT INC.
2. SAINT ROSE TRANSIT, INC.
3. JASPER JEAN SERVICES, INC.

for PITX - MANGGAHAN, GENERAL TRIAS route with the use of thirty-five (35) authorized PUB units, under the selection/qualification process on 9 September 2019 pursuant to Resolution No. 218 series of 2019;

WHEREAS, DON ALDRIN TRANSPORT INC. and SAINT ROSE TRANSIT, INC. were given a rating of “**PASSED/QUALIFIED**” as both applicants have fully complied with the Qualification Requirements - Legal, Technical and Financial Capability Qualifications provided under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013;

WHEREAS, the Committee found that JASPER JEAN SERVICES, INC. failed to submit/provide the following documentary requirements set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013, to wit:

1. Original or certified true copies of its Certificate of Incorporation and Articles and By-Laws;
2. Undertaking that the units shall be compliant with the specifications and standards under OFG and DTI-PNS;
3. Undertaking that the applicant will immediately comply with the approved LPTRP/DOTr rationalization study;
4. Fleet Management System with organized vehicle dispatch procedures;
5. Evidence of formal arrangement with Automatic Fare Collection (AFC) service provider that will offer inter-operable AFC service that is fully compliant with fare media related technical specifications;
6. Copy of Letter of Support from property owners/managers regarding access to, or use of, each off-street loading and unloading area in MANGGAHAN, GENERAL TRIAS endpoint;
7. Proof of financial capability of at least equal to the set-aside bank deposit, duly certified by the depository bank, which is equivalent to one hundred thousand pesos (Php 100,000.00) for PUB services per unit.

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, this Committee resolves to recommend to the Board to:

1. **DENY** the application of JASPER JEAN SERVICES, INC. for failing to comply with the requirements set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013;
2. **CONDUCT A PUBLIC LOTTERY** between DON ALDRIN TRANSPORT INC. and SAINT ROSE TRANSIT, INC. to determine which applicant will be selected for the route PITX - MANGGAHAN, GENERAL TRIAS and to proceed for the application for issuance of Certificate of Public Convenience.
