MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 2019-030
(SANGLEY AIRPORT ROUTES)

WHEREAS, on 4 July 2019, this Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2019-030 also known as the “Opening of Applications for the Issuance of New Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC) to operate P2P route/s among which is the Sangley Point Airport”;

WHEREAS, after two (2) calls for interest (dated 26 July 2019 and 9 August 2019) no submissions of letter of intent and qualification documents were received by the Office of the Executive Director for the SANGLEY AIRPORT/CAVITE CITY - PITX route, hence, deemed a failure to solicit interest;

WHEREAS, on 2 August 2019, the 2nd Qualification Committee (pursuant to LTFRB Office Order No. 2019-114) issued its Resolution numbered 212, series of 2019, wherein the committee resolved to recommend to the Board to award the SANGLEY AIRPORT/CAVITE CITY - NAIA route in favor of its lone applicant SAULOG TRANSIT, INC.;

WHEREAS, the Board issued on 15 August 2019 the Notice of Selection in favor of SAULOG TRANSIT, INC.

WHEREAS, PITX is proximate to NAIA, such that the former can be passed by before heading to NAIA from Sangley Point Airport, and vice-versa;

WHEREAS, PITX can be a Special Stop for the route “SANGLEY AIRPORT/CAVITE CITY - NAIA” to ensure the provision of public transportation services connecting Sangley Airport and NAIA to an intermodal landport such as PITX;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, the Board hereby **AMENDS** the route “SANGLEY AIRPORT/CAVITE CITY - NAIA” of Memorandum Circular No. 2019-030 to include PITX as its special stop as awarded to SAULOG TRANSIT, INC.:
