RESOLUTION NO. 293 Series of 2019

(Re: RE-OPENING OF ROUTES from previous Memorandum Circulars relative to the implementation of the Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program – applications on the route: BALINGASA, BALINTAWAK - MUZON, SAN JOSE DEL MONTE, BULACAN)

WHEREAS, before this Committee are the applications of the following, to wit:

1. MUZON BALINTAWAK TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE
2. MUZON SJDM TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE
3. DEL MONTE CITY TRANS, INC.
4. EXPRESS TSC

for BALINGASA, BALINTAWAK - MUZON, SAN JOSE DEL MONTE, BULACAN route with the use of twenty-nine (29) authorized Class 3 PUJ units, under the selection/qualification process on 13 September 2019 pursuant to Resolution No. 217 series of 2019;

WHEREAS, the Committee also found that MUZON BALINTAWAK TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE failed to submit/provide the following documentary requirements set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013, to wit:

1. Undertaking to deliver the required number of units (as follows: 25% within three (3) months, 50% within six (6) months and 100% within nine (9) months) duly certified by the vehicle manufacturer/supplier;
2. Fleet Management System;
3. Proposed garage/depot space pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 2017-027 or undertaking to have a compliant garage with zoning clearance;
4. Manner of acquisition for the compliant PUV units identifying the funding source and with detailed financing plan;

WHEREAS, the Committee found that MUZON SJDM TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE failed to submit/provide its undertaking that the subject cooperative will immediately comply with the approved LPTRP or DOTr route rationalization study;

WHEREAS, the Committee found that DEL MONTE CITY TRANS, INC. were given a rating of "PASSED/QUALIFIED" as it fully complied with the Qualification Requirements - Legal, Technical and Financial Capability Qualifications provided under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013;

WHEREAS, the Committee found that EXPRESS TSC failed to submit/provide all documentary requirements set forth under the Legal, Technical and Financial Capability requirements set forth under the Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, this Committee resolves to recommend to the Board to:

1. **DENY** the applications of MUZON BALINTAWAK TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE, MUZON SJDM TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE and EXPRESS TSC for

the subject route for failing to comply with the documentary requirements set forth under the Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013. This is however without prejudice on their part to re-apply or submit application once the route is subsequently re-opened;

2. **AWARD** the BALINGASA, BALINTAWAK - MUZON, SAN JOSE DEL MONTE, BULACAN route in favor of DEL MONTE CITY TRANS, INC.;
