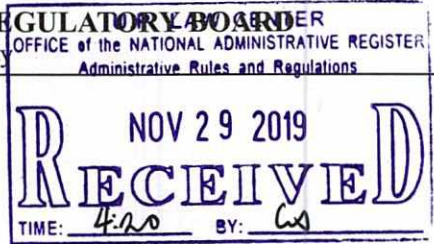

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NUMBER 2019- 063

SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 2011-004 (2011 Revised Terms and Conditions of Certificate of Public Convenience and Providing Penalties for Violations Thereof)

WHEREAS, on 25 May 2011, this Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2011-004, Revised Terms and Conditions of Certificate of Public Convenience and Providing Penalties for Violations Thereof;

WHEREAS, on 02 June 2014, Joint Administrative Order No. 2014-01, Revised Schedule of Fines and Penalties for Violations of Laws, Rules and Regulations Governing Land Transportation incorporating the 2011 Revised Terms and Conditions of Certificate of Public Convenience and Providing Penalties for Violations Thereof, was issued;

WHEREAS, on 10 February 2017, this Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2017-004, Approving the 2017 LTFRB Citizen’s Charter and Mandating Its Primacy Over Inconsistent Provisions of LTFRB Issuances;

WHEREAS, on 16 May 2017, Executive Order No. 26 was issued Providing for the Establishment of Smoke-Free Environments in Public and Enclosed Places;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, Item #2 of the 2011 Revised Terms and Conditions of Certificate of Public Convenience and Providing Penalties for Violations Thereof is hereby amended as follows:

“2. The PUV operator shall prohibit smoking lighted cigarette and/or **electronic cigarette/vape** or the act of carrying a lighted cigarette or other tobacco products and/or **the act of vaping** within the terminal/garage or inside all PUVs and shall cause the prominent display of the “No Smoking” signs within the premises of the terminal/garage and inside all PUVs.”

PENALTY

Violation of the aforesaid term and condition shall be penalized as follows:

Fine of P15,000.00 and cancellation of CPC
where the unit is authorized

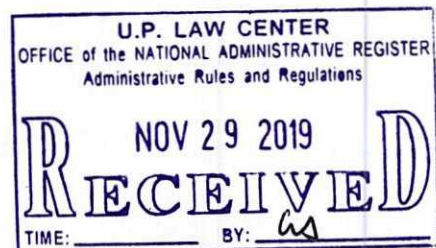
