RESOLUTION NO. 313 Series of 2019

(Re: Opening of Applications for the Issuance of New Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC) under the initial implementation of the Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program approved during the 18th Board Meeting – Second qualification process on the route: MCKINLEY, TAGUIG - ROSARIO PASIG)

WHEREAS, before this Committee are the applications of I-SHALOM CORP. and NEW OPERATOR'S TRANSPORT SERVICE COOP. for the MCKINLEY, TAGUIG - ROSARIO PASIG route with the use of fifteen (15) authorized Class 3 UV units, under the second qualification process on 18 September 2019 executed upon the failure of the initial qualification process on 27 August 2019, pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 2019-039;

WHEREAS, I-SHALOM CORP. were given a rating of "PASSED/QUALIFIED" as it fully complied with the Qualification Requirements - Legal, Technical and Financial Capability Qualifications provided under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013;


WHEREAS, the Committee found that NEW OPERATOR'S TRANSPORT SERVICE COOP. failed to submit/provide the following documentary requirements set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013, to wit:

1. Undertaking as to the delivery of the 25%, 50% and 100% required compliant units within three (3), six (6) and nine (9) months respectively as certified by the vehicle manufacturer/supplier;
2. Undertaking that the units shall be compliant with the specifications and standards under OFG and DTI-PNS;
3. Undertaking that New Operator's Transport Service Coop. will immediately comply with the approved rationalization study;
4. Fleet Management System with organized vehicle dispatch procedures;
5. Copy of Letter of Support from property owners/managers regarding access to, or use of, each off-street loading and unloading area in Rosario, Pasig endpoint;
6. Original or Certified True Copy of the latest Audited Financial Statement and duly stamped "received" by the BIR or its Authorized Agent Banks;
7. Manner of acquisition for the compliant PUV units identifying the funding source and with detailed financing plan/proof/s of support from funding source;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, this Committee resolves to recommend to the Board to:


1. **DENY** the application of NEW OPERATOR'S TRANSPORT SERVICE COOP. for failure to comply with the provisions set forth under the Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013.
2. **AWARD** the MCKINLEY, TAGUIG - ROSARIO PASIG route in favor of I-SHALOM CORP.


