RESOLUTION NO. 315 Series of 2019

(Re: Opening of Applications for the Issuance of New Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC) under the initial implementation of the Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program approved during the 18th Board Meeting – Second qualification process on the route: FAIRVIEW TERRACES - BAGUMBONG VIA CALOOCAN SPORTS COMPLEX)

WHEREAS, before this Committee is the application of TRIBE OPERATOR'S TRANSPORT SERVICE AND MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE for the FAIRVIEW TERRACES - BAGUMBONG VIA CALOOCAN SPORTS COMPLEX route with the use of fifteen (15) authorized Class 2 PUJ units, under the second qualification process on 18 September 2019 executed upon the failure of the initial qualification process on 27 August 2019, pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 2019-039;

WHEREAS, there was only one applicant who submitted a letter of intent on the said route;


WHEREAS, the Committee found that TRIBE OPERATOR'S TRANSPORT SERVICE AND MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE failed to submit/provide its copy of letter of support from property owners/managers regarding access to, or use of, each off-street loading and unloading area in the Bagumbong endpoint;

WHEREAS, the Committee found that the submitted copy of its latest audited financial statement by TRIBE OPERATOR'S TRANSPORT SERVICE AND MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE is not duly received by the BIR;

WHEREAS, the Committee found that TRIBE OPERATOR'S TRANSPORT SERVICE AND MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE provided its financial capability with insufficient amount of set-aside deposit in contrast to the requirement of fifty thousand pesos (Php 50,000.00) for PUJ services per unit, multiplied by the total number of vehicles for the route;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, this Committee resolves to recommend to the Board to **DENY** the application of TRIBE OPERATOR'S TRANSPORT SERVICE AND MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE for failing to comply with the provisions set forth under the Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013 and **RE-OPEN** the subject route to prospective applicants.


