RESOLUTION NO. 024 Series of 2020

(Re: Submission of documents by Golden Transport Service & Multi-Purpose Cooperative relative to its application for the route Brgy. Paliparan, Dasmariñas, Cavite to PITX via Molino and Molino, Bacoor, Cavite to PITX under MC No. 2018-027)

WHEREAS, on 4 December 2019, the Qualification Committee issued its Resolution No. 303 and 307 S. 2019 wherein the committee resolved to DIRECT Golden Transport Service & Multi-Purpose Cooperative to SUBMIT within fifteen (15) days from receipt of the aforementioned Resolution the *undertaking that 25%, 50% and 100% of the number of required/proposed units will be delivered within three (3), six (6) and nine (9) months respectively as certified by the vehicle manufacturer/supplier;*

WHEREAS, Golden Transport Service & Multi-Purpose Cooperative received the above-mentioned resolutions on 6 December 2019;

WHEREAS, on 9 December 2019, Golden Transport Service & Multi-Purpose Cooperative submitted its duly signed and notarized undertaking dated 9 December 2019, certified by the AVP - Sales of Hino Motors Phils. Corp. - Oliver C. Dela Cruz for each of the following routes, to wit:

1. Brgy. Paliparan, Dasmariñas, Cavite to PITX via Molino with proposed fifty-five (55) UV number of units, the applicant stated thus:

“a) twenty five percent (25%) of the said units or fourteen (14) units shall be delivered within three (3) months from the date of submission of the pre-qualification documents;

b) fifty percent (50%) of the said units or twenty-eight (28) units shall be delivered within six (6) months from the date of submission of pre-qualification documents

c) one hundred percent (100%) of the said units or fifty-five (55) units or the entire units applied for shall be delivered within nine (9) months from the date of submission of pre-qualification documents, which shall all be in compliance with LTFRB Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013.”

2. Molino, Bacoor, Cavite to PITX with proposed twenty-seven (27) UV number of units, the applicant stated thus:

“a) twenty five percent (25%) of the said units or seven (7) units shall be delivered within three (3) months from the date of submission of the pre-qualification documents;

b) fifty percent (50%) of the said units or fourteen (14) units shall be delivered within six (6) months from the date of submission of pre-qualification documents

c) one hundred percent (100%) of the said units or twenty seven (27) units or the entire units applied for shall be delivered within nine (9) months from the date of submission of pre-qualification documents, which shall all be in compliance with LTFRB Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013.”

WHEREAS, upon careful evaluation, the Qualification Committee finds that the above-mentioned submitted documents are fully compliant with the requirements set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013;

WHEREAS, Golden Transport Service & Multi-Purpose Cooperative were given a rating of “PASSED/QUALIFIED” as it fully complied with the Qualification Requirements - Legal, Technical and Financial Capability provided under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, this Committee resolves to recommend to the Board to **AWARD** and **AUTHORIZE** the applied fifty-five (55) Class 3 units for the UV route Brgy. Paliparan, Dasmariñas, Cavite to PITX via Molino & twenty-seven (27) Class 3 units for the UV route Molino, Bacoor, Cavite to PITX under Memorandum Circular No. 2018-027 in favor of Golden Transport Service & Multi-Purpose Cooperative.
