

RESOLUTION NO. 041 Series of 2020⁴
**(Re: PETITION FOR DISQUALIFICATION FILED BY MAPS
TRANSPORT SERVICE COOP.)**

WHEREAS, MAPS Transport Services Cooperative (MAPS) has participated in the Selection Process for Utility Vehicle (UV) Express Services (Class 3) on the route PITX – TANZA pursuant to Board Resolution No. 218, Series of 2019.

WHEREAS, Petition for Disqualification was filed by MAPS on September 16, 2019 seeking for the disqualification of Bee Liner Corp., likewise a participant of the Selection on the aforesaid route.

WHEREAS, During the evaluation of the qualification documents of Bee Liner Corp., the undersigned members of the Committee found that all the documents required under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013 has been complied by BEE LINER CORP., thus Resolution No. 261 Series of 2019 dated November 19, 2019 was issued by the undersigned members of the Committee, which AWARDED the PITX-TANZA route in favor of BEE LINER CORP., and DENIED the application of MAPS among others.

WHEREAS, the issuance of Resolution No. 261 Series of 2019 have rendered the subject Petition for Disqualification moot and academic.

WHEREAS, Nevertheless, the Committee has deliberated on the Petition for Disqualification, and revisited the implementing guidelines provided under MC 2019-013 and Department Order No, 2017-011, particularly the pertinent items thereat, and still finds BEE LINER EXPRESS CORP. fully compliant with the legal, technical, and financial capability requirements set forth under MC 2019-013.

WHEREAS, it should be emphasized that "Factual findings of administrative bodies, such as this Board, should be accorded not only respect, but even finality as they are supported by substantial evidence even if not overwhelming or preponderant." (*Casa Filipino Realty Corp. vs. Office of the President*, 241 SCRA 165)

NOW THEREFORE, the Committee resolves to as it is hereby resolved to **DISMISS** the Petition for Disqualification filed by MAPS TRANSPORT SERVICE COOP. for utter lack of merit, and shall **STAND** on our Resolutions issued relative to the Selection Process of PITX – TANZA route
